## Africa Climate Week 2022, Gabon, 29 August to 1 September, 2022

Africa Climate Week 2022 is a step on the road to COP27 in Egypt. Last year, regional collaboration emerged as a driver of global progress. The Glasgow Climate Pact agreed at COP26 recognizes Regional Climate Weeks as a platform for governments and stakeholders to strengthen credible and durable response to climate change. ACW 2022 will be held from 29 August to 1 September in Gabon. ACW 2022 is a collaboration platform to explore: resilience against climate risks, the transition to a lowemission economy, and partnerships to solve pressing challenges. The event is organized by UN Climate Change in collaboration with global partners UN Development Programme, UN Environment Programme and the World Bank Group. Partners in the region include the Africa Union, the Africa Development Bank (AfDB) and the UN Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA).
